- BayRun: Thank you to the BayRun organising committee for a fantastic community event.
- Athletics Carnival: Held at the end of last term and was very successful. 41 Students represented our school at the Zone carnival last week. The Zone Athletics Carnival was held at Sydney Olympic Park and was a good day, despite the rainy weather. We are still waiting to hear who has qualified for the regional carnival.
- Representative sport: Lily (Yr. 6) represented the school at the State Netball competition last week. The Sydney East team finished second, which is a great achievement. Lily & Rose (Yr. 6) will compete in the State Soccer championships in Tamworth next week.
- Glowtastic Disco: Thanks to Anna for organising the event. It was a great hit with the students, and everyone had a wonderful time.
- Parent Teacher Interviews were held at the end of last term and the turnout was good. 85% (112 Bookings) of parents booked interviews using the app. The total number of interviews may have been higher as some parents booked directly with the teachers.
- Talent Quest was held at the end of Term 2 and was great fun. Lots of students participated and it was a lovely way to end the term.
- Spelling Bee: The Premier's Spelling Bee for students in Stage 2 and Stage 3 was held at the end of last term. A representative from Stage 2 and Stage 3 will participate in the Regional Finals this week.
