## Principal's Report June 2024

- Department of education budget adjustments were implemented as expected. The school's financial position has been maintained. A 7<sup>th</sup> teacher has been budgeted for in 2025.

- Cross Country carnival was successful.
- Representative sport has been very successful. 32 Students represented DPPS at the Zone Cross Country Carnival and 7 Students qualified for the regional carnival. One student has been selected to participate in the state carnival and 2 are in the reserve team.
- Students have been selected for the zone teams in boys and girls soccer and 1 student has been selected for netball. The girls zone team won their competition and two students have been selected for the state team.
