## **3. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (SUE)**

Principal's Report November 2021

- Everything is proceeding quietly, and the new routines are working to keep cohorts separate where possible.
- Mindfulness lessons have started. The lessons were delayed by a week due to staffing issues with the company. We preferred to wait until the sessions could be held face-to-face, so they started this week. The sessions will conclude in Week 10 (10 Dec).
- Jasmin's Playground was officially opened on Monday 25 October. Only students in Year 5 and Year 3 attended. Matari dedicated the playground open in memory of Jasmine.
- Semester 2 Student achievement reports: As a result of the interruption to regular schooling caused by the COVID-19 global pandemic, the Semester 2, 2021 progress reports will be a simplified version of the report usually provided. Information describing achievements in English, mathematics, general learning and work habits will be provided.
- Senior toilet renovation has started. About 50% complete at the moment and appears to be on track for completion early December.
- Quotes are being obtained to replace the soft fall tiles on the terraced steps with rubber soft fall.
- Decodable Readers – are being used by students in K-2 now. We will look at purchasing more early in 2022.
- Musical instruments have been ordered shortly. The order was not submitted due to the lockdown.
- Kindergarten Orientation – Parent Zoom session last Friday and students will attend 2 x sessions starting this Friday.

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- TTFM Surveys – Link in newsletter and email. Encourage parents to complete and its' part of our self-evaluation.
- Student leadership election process has started. Candidate speeches are being held this week and parents of the candidates can watch the speeches via a Zoom link. Elections are next Wednesday, and the school captains will be announced on presentation day on 9 December.
- Presentation Day – Thursday 9 Dec – There will be three separate sessions to keep cohorts separate. No parents are permitted to attend, and we are not allowed to have any concerts or performances. Parents will have the opportunity to attend Zoom webinar to watch the award presentations. Details will be available soon.

- Year 6 graduation dinner can go ahead on 15 Dec. Parents can attend because it is at an off-site venue. Presentation will be held at the dinner.
