4.PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (SUE)

Principal's Report September 2021

- Home learning has continued. Thank you for the ongoing support we are receiving from our parents and caregivers. Feedback from parents has been overwhelmingly positive. Some issues raised, but they have been resolved. Activities have continued in literacy & numeracy and included Stage 3 solar cars, sock puppets and potato Olympics, just for fun.
- At this stage, students will return to home learning from Tuesday 5 October. Then there will be a staged return to school from 25 October. The Department will update this information closer to the end of the school holidays. Ventilation of classrooms is being audited at the moment, but it is expected our school will be fine as all rooms have opening windows and ceiling fans.
- Mindfulness lessons will take place once all students return (from Week 6) for four weeks. This is designed to help settle students back into the routine of school after a long period of home learning. Students will engage in two lessons each week for four weeks.
- George Mavromatis – former student of our school, sent in a proposal to put bird nesting boxes in trees at the school. This is a good environmental initiative and the school supports the proposal. Once COVID-19 restrictions are lifted, we will involve George in the project.
- Premiers Reading Challenge – 83% of students at the school completed the challenge. This is a great result!
- Asset Management Unit has arranged quote for the refurbishment of the senior toilets. Best price so far is approx. \$ 86K (may be \$18K less if we reuse existing urinals as suggested by the contractor). It is hoped the work can take place early in Term 4.
