3. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (SUE)

- COVID-19 restrictions have been relaxed since 8 March. Parents and caregivers are now permitted on school grounds, but still need to sign in at the front office. Social distancing requirements are still in place.
- Small group learning support and extension groups have started.
- Asset Services are organising a tender for OSHC services at the school. Thanks to the two parent reps (Simon & Sarah) who volunteered. The tender will be advertised on 30 March and will run for 21 days. The new licence will operate from the beginning of Term 3.
- The Chromebooks purchased from the Colour Run funds have arrived at school.
- School swimming carnival was a great success and a beautiful day. 16 students qualified to participate in the Zone carnival on 10 March, which was also a successful day.
- We have had several students try out for Zone AFL, Rugby League and Netball representative competitions. It is very competitive and we wish them luck. Some have been selected for AFL & rugby league. Netball trials are still ongoing.
- PSSA will start next term. Students who do not participate in PSSA will participate in a basketball clinic at school. Trials for PSSA will happen next week. All students are being encouraged to try out for a team. At this stage, teams will include boys soccer, girls soccer and girls netball. There will be a junior and senior team in each sport.
- We have received a good response to the community consultation for the strategic improvement plan. The feedback has been constructive and very helpful. The strategic improvement plan will be published on our website early next term.
- Interest groups have started on Friday afternoons for all grades from Year 1-Year 6. Activities include kitchen science, photography, drawing, dance and ceramics & drama. The students seem very positive.
- PBL Reward: Celebration for filling the responsibility box with tokens. The reward was an extended recess and a play date with teachers. Very well received by students.
- Sandpit: We have decided to make it into a garden as it is the easiest and most cost effective option. Bill will organise delivery of the soil to happen during the school holidays, weather permitting.
- Jasmin's playground: Asset Management Unit (AMU) are currently looking at quotes and hope to start the process as soon as possible. Latest quote was high, but included additional work to the original quote. The school will meet with AMU & contractor to refine scope of work to reduce cost of project. New quote should be available for the next meeting.
